# **Chengdu International School**

We are a vibrant international community that provides transformative, holistic Pre K–12 education to develop globally minded individuals who learn, love and lead. As a LifePlus international school, we inspire our students to go and make a life-changing difference for the common good.

# School + community

Chengdu International School is a college preparatory international school, serving expatriate students from age 3 through Grade 12. The school follows American standards of education with English as the primary language of instruction. The faculty is comprised of American teachers, as well as teachers from China, Korea and around the world. All teachers must be licensed with at least a bachelor's degree. Enrollment at Chengdu is approximately 250 students from than 20 countries.

#### Curriculum

We offer an American, college-preparatory curriculum with Pre-AP, AP and AP Capstone programs for high school students. Chengdu International School is one of only two international schools in the world that offers exclusive Pre-AP Programming to 9th and 10th graders as part of a highly rigorous academic program. Students continue to receive AP Capstone Diplomas and AP Scholar with Distinction certificates year-to-year as part of this distinctive program.

## Co-curricular activities

In Athletics, Chengdu offers boys' and girls' competitive basketball, cross country, soccer, swimming and volleyball. Students also can participate in Model United Nations (MUN), the National English Honors Society (NEHS), the Sichuan Science Fair, the LifePlus Fine Arts Festival, the Student Advisory Council, choir, band, public speaking, drama, chess competitions and service trips to various locations in Asia.

# Graduation + credit requirements


- 24 credits are required for graduation.
- One half-credit is given for each full semester of a course successfully completed in Grades 9–12. The following credits must be earned in order to graduate:






